The aftermath has resulted into the development of corporate governance codes in many jurisdictions. Countries such as the United Kingdom, Germany, South Africa, etc. have continued to build their codes over the years. Whilst the corporate governance culture is evolving in Nigeria, there are still uncertainties on its extent and who should chart the course. The *Miyetti Quarterly Law Review* therefore solicits articles on corporate governance, not limited to the following sub-themes:

- Theories of corporate governance and its application to corporate practice
- Models of corporate governance
- Duties of directors and corporate governance
- Corporate governance and financial reporting
- Duties of auditors and corporate governance
- Corporate governance and regulation of Nongovernmental organisations in Nigeria
- Voluntariness and otherwise of corporate governance requirements
- Regulation of corporate governance in Nigeria
- Corporate governance in the banking Sector
- Corporate governance in the telecommunications industry
- Corporate governance and the oil and gas industry
- The role of corporate governance in project finance
- Corporate governance in the public sector
- Corporate governance and other jurisdictions
