N1,110,000,000.00 PAYMENTS TO PAUL USORO & CO BY AKWA IBOM STATE GOVERNMENT BETWEEN 2015-2016

Further to your letter of 28 May 2018 inviting me for a meeting that would provide "clarification" in respect of "a case" that is being investigated by the Commission and my subsequent meeting with you yesterday, 04 June 2018, I write to confirm that the Akwa Ibom State Government indeed made payments to Paul Usoro & Co between 2015 and 2016 totaling N1,110,000,000.00 being payments-on-account in respect of several matters that we were and are still handling for the State Government.

The Table below shows the payments and the dates thereof plus the details of our Notes of Charges, the photocopies of which are hereto attached and pursuant to which the payments were made:

As you would glean from our referenced Notes of Charges, these payments-on-account were made by the Akwa Ibom State Government in respect of several dispute resolution matters that we handled and are still handling for the State. Attached to this letter is a

non-exhaustive list of these matters with the facts and status thereof fully set out for your information and guidance.

It remains for us to add that the outstanding fees due to us from the State Government in respect of these matters is far in excess of what has so far been paid on account and, prior to your letter, we have been in the process of reconciling and settling accounts with the State Government. Also please note that, this list of non-exhaustive dispute resolution matters which we are handling for AKSG does not include transactional matters which we have handled and are still handling for the State Government and its agencies and for which we are yet to be paid.

We hope that these facts clarify issues for you in the terms of your investigations.
