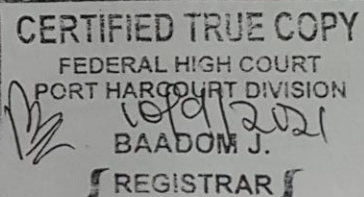
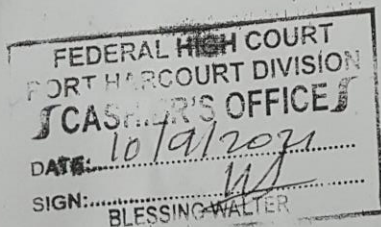

Parties are absent.


**IT IS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**
