

COMMUNIQUE ISSUED BY JUSUN AFTER SERIES OF MEETINGS AND AGREEMENTS WITH THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE HONOURABLE, THE CHIEF JUSTICE OF NIGERIA AND RELEVANT STAKEHOLDERS ON 3<sup>RD</sup> JUNE, 2025.

After long deliberations upon issues that led to the declaration of industrial action by JUSUN on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of June, 2025. The following agreement was reached:


- That the JUSUN oblige the noble intervention of the Honourable, the Chief Justice of Nigeria, Hon. Justice Kudirat Motunmori Olatokunbo Kekere-Ekun, GCON, the Honourable Minister of Labour and Employment- Alhaji Muhammad Maigari Dingyadi, NLC and other Stakeholders.
- To give the Honourable Chief Justice of Nigeria and the relevant stakeholders to engage the Federal Government of Nigeria to ensure the release of funds to the Judiciary within the period of one month.
- That upon the release of the funds to the Judiciary, the demands by the JUSUN; implementation of the N70,000.00 new minimum wage and its arrears, 25/35% salary increase and 5months wage award and their arrears to be implemented immediately.




