1. That the Applicants are entitled to fair hearing as guaranteed under Section 36 (1) of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (As Amended).
2. That the continued hearing of this Charge by this Honourable Court will amount to a breach of the Applicants' constitutional right to fair hearing.
3. That this Honourable Court per Hon. Justice Jude Onwuegbuzie is manifestly biased against the Defendants, especially the 1st Defendant.
4. That this Honourable Court has foreknowledge of the Charge based on request and arrangement between the Nominal Complainant, Asabe Waziri, Joe Agi (SAN), AIG Oyakire Ekeinde (rtd.), Mohammed Bakodo Abubakar and the office of the Chief Judge of FCT High Court.
5. That the Defendants have no confidence in getting justice from the Court of Hon Justice Onwuegbuzie Jude.
6. That the Charge and trial are prearranged by Asabe Waziri, Nominal Complainant, Joe Agi SAN, AIG Oyakhire Ekeinde (rtd) former Director, Legal, Nigerian Police Force and Mohammed Bakodo Abubakar and the office of the Chief Judge of FCT High Court to deal with the Defendants like Asabe Waziri has boasted.
7. That justice must not only be done, but must be seen to be done.
8. That it is in the utmost interest of justice that this application is granted.
