hereby Order is 2. **That** an compelling and directing the Respondent to immediately release to the Applicant within 7 days from the date of the judgment/or of the Honourable Court certified true copies of the following documents:

 The report of the investigation conducted by the IGP-Monitoring team led by Mr. Chinedu arising from the petition of Falana & Falana dated the 23/11/2023.



 - 3. John Eze, and;
 - Oriole aka T-boy and any other officer(s) indicted and recommended for prosecution by the then CP-Legal, Mr. Tuesday Emienbo vide the legal opinion.
 - 5. **That** the sum of N2,000,000.00 (Two million naira) only is awarded as damages against the Respondents for serial violations of the Applicant's constitutional and/or statutory right to the report (s) of the investigations into her complaints of the abduction and disappearance of her husband, John Chukwuemeka Anozie.
