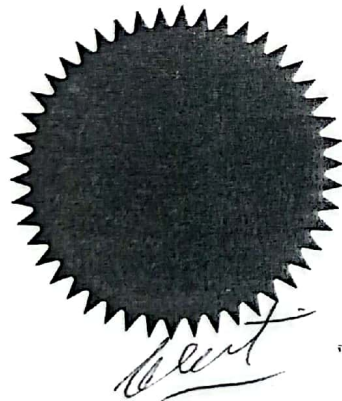

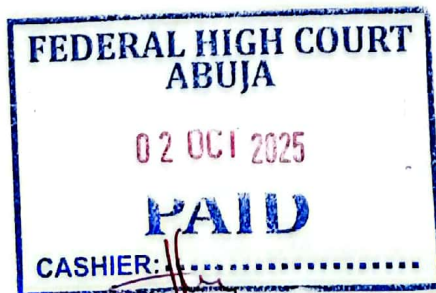
JUDGMENT ORDER

 4. Oriole aka T-boy and any other officer(s) indicted and recommended for prosecution by the then CP-Legal, Mr. Tuesday Emienbo vide the legal opinion.
- c. The sum of **N50,000,000.00** (Fifty million naira) as damages against the Respondent for serial violations of the Applicant's constitutional and/or statutory right to the report (s) of the investigations into her complaints of the abduction and disappearance of her husband, John Chukwuemeka Anozie.

UPON READING the affidavit in support of the application sworn to by Nnenna Anozie, (Mrs) Female, Adult, Christian, Nigerian citizen of No. 8, Baale Street, Lekki, Lagos State, and filed at this Honourable Court Registry.

3. **That** an Order is hereby made compelling and directing the Respondent to immediately forward to the Honourable Attorney-General of the Federation within 7 days from the date of the judgment of the Honourable Court the case filed on the abduction and disappearance of Mr. John Chukwuemeka Anozie inclusive of the following documents;

4. **That** an Order is hereby made compelling and directing the Respondent to hand over to the Attorney-General of the Federation for prosecution before the appropriate Court the following officers;

1. ASP. Anthony Obiozor Ikechukwu (retired),
2. SGT. Uzochukwu Emeana,
3. John Eze, and;
4. Oriole aka T-boy and any other officer(s) indicted and recommended for prosecution by the then CP-Legal, Mr. Tuesday Emienbo vide the legal opinion.

5. **That** the sum of N2,000,000.00 (Two million naira) only is awarded as damages against the Respondents for serial violations of the Applicant's constitutional and/or statutory right to the report (s) of the investigations into her complaints of the abduction and disappearance of her husband, John Chukwuemeka Anozie.
