## **NOTICE TO ALL ASPIRANTS**

All aspirants scheduled to be called to the Bar on the 25th day of November, 2025 are to note the following:

#### 1. PRE-CALL ACTIVITIES:

- a. Each aspirant is to upload the name of his or her guest on the portal via https://calltobarbob.com.ng/ (Note that each aspirant is entitled to one guest only).
- b. Each aspirant who has successfully uploaded the information in (a) above, is expected to pick up the invitation card for the guest at the Body of Benchers Complex. Issuance of invitation cards shall commence on Friday, 21st November 2025 by 10:00am and end on Monday, 24th November, 2025 by 4:00pm.

#### 2. CALL TO BAR ACTIVITES:

- a. Accreditation for aspirants and their guest shall commence from 7:00am and end by 9:00am on the day of Call (25th November, 2025).
- b. Each aspirant is to come along with his/her Nigerian Law School ID card for identification while each guest whose name have been uploaded on the portal and has an invitation card is to be identified with a valid means of identification.
- c. Dress code:

# Female Aspirants:

- Black suit with skirt (no trousers), white camisole, white collarette, black covered shoes (No high heels). Skirts should be below the knee, corporate and must be plain, and adorn with Lawyer's gown and wig (wigs shall be worn after being called to the Bar). However, pregnant women may put on black corporate gown whose length shall be below the knee.
- Only natural hair is permitted, coloured hair or attachments are not permitted.
- No artificial nails, no painting of nails, no henna, no artificial eye lashes, no heavy makeup, small single earrings are permitted (not dangling earrings).

## Male Aspirants:

- Black suit, plain, white shirt, bibs, black shoes, lawyers' wig and gown.
- Neat low haircuts.
- No use of neck or wrist accessories except wristwatch
- No dark shades (except on medical grounds which must be supported by medical report).
