**RE: DEFAMATORY AND FALSE PUBLICATION CONCERNING MR. ABUBAKAR SULEIMAN MAYAKI**

We are Solicitors to Mr. Abubakar Suleiman Mayaki (hereinafter referred to as "*our client*"), and we write on his firm instructions in respect of your publication titled "*Lagos Magistrate Court Indicts Abubakar Suleiman Mayaki on Two (2) Count Charge of Murder*" circulated on your platform.

Our client's attention has been drawn to the said publication, which is false, misleading, reckless, and defamatory.

Take notice that the incident referred to in your publication allegedly occurred as far back as the year 2004. However, your report was deliberately framed and presented in a manner that falsely suggests that the matter is a current and ongoing judicial process, thereby creating a false impression in the minds of the public.

This distortion of facts is not only misleading but is calculated to embarrass, scandalize, and unjustly malign our client, exposing him to public odium, ridicule, and contempt.

Furthermore, contrary to your publication, the legal advice issued by DPP exonerated our client completely and there was no subsisting or continuing criminal proceeding as insinuated in respect of the matter. The ruling of the court, which is already in the public domain, clearly contradicts your assertions.

By publishing these defamatory words without due verification, your organization has **gravely injured our client's reputation, integrity, and standing in society**, particularly by imputing criminal conduct where none subsists. Your conduct fell far below the ethics of your profession

In view of the foregoing, we hereby **formally demand** the following:

1. **An immediate retraction** of the said publication on all your platforms;
2. **A public apology**, accorded the same prominence as the original publication;  
and
3. A written undertaking to refrain from further defamatory publications against our client.

**TAKE NOTICE** that unless these demands are complied with within **forty-eight (48) hours** from receipt of this letter, we have our client's firm instructions to **commence legal proceedings against your organization without further notice**, seeking all remedies available in law, including damages, injunctions, and costs.

This letter is issued **without prejudice to our client's rights**, all of which are expressly reserved.
