SECTION 254C(1)(a), (c), (k), (l), (m) AND (n) OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE
FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA, 1999 (CFRN) (AS ALTERED); SECTION 36(1),
(9) AND SECTION 174 OF THE CFRN, 1999 (AS ALTERED); RULE 33 OF THE
RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT FOR LEGAL PRACTITIONERS, 2023;
THE LABOUR Act, Cap. L1 LFN 2004; AND THE INHERENT JURISDICTION OF
