APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION INTO 2026/2027 ACADEMIC SESSION (BAR PART II PROGRAMME)

The Nigerian Law School is set to commence the admission process for the Bar Part II 2026/2027 Academic Session.

All intending applicants are hereby informed that the Portal will be open for the completion and submission of application forms from Monday, 7 September, 2026.

The session will commence simultaneously at the Headquarters, Bwari, Abuja and Campuses in Lagos, Enugu, Kano, Yenagoa, Yola and Port Harcourt on Monday, 22 February, 2027.

Admission Requirements:

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates who satisfy the following requirements:

1. Nigerian graduates of Law from Nigerian universities.
2. Nigerian graduates of Law from non-common law jurisdictions who have successfully completed a remedial programme at a Nigerian university.
3. Foreign-trained law graduates who have successfully completed and passed the Bar Part I Course at the Nigerian Law School.

Method of Application: Intending applicants should visit the Nigerian Law School website at www.nigerianlawschool.edu.ng for instructions on the application procedure.

Note: Only applicants whose data have been forwarded to the Nigerian Law School by the Registrar of their university not later than Friday, 4 September, 2026 are eligible to apply.

Each applicant must therefore confirm with his/her university before proceeding to pay the application fee of forty thousand (₦40,000.00) Naira. Please note that application fees are non-refundable.

Closing Date: Downloaded application forms together with references on applicants must be completed and returned to the Nigerian Law School via the applicants' Dean of Law **on or before Thursday, December 31, 2026.**

Re-admission Applicants: Approved re-admission and cleared referred admission cases are to check for their names under re-admission on the Portal and then apply. Such applicants are to attach a copy of the approval for readmission or clearance letter to the application forms, and dispatch to the Secretary to the Council and Director of Administration, Nigerian Law School Headquarters **on or before Thursday, December 31, 2026.**

Late submission of Application Forms will not be entertained.

Applicants are hereby advised to note and retain their application number, as it will be required for all future correspondence and enquiries relating to their application.
